- System testing, including specs, procedures and results analysis.

DELIVERABLES

As this service is designed for flexibility, the deliverables depend on the exact options selected. The deliverables for review activities include:

- All formal review checklists are completed and cross-checked.
- All problem reports are filed in the agreed tool and/or format.

The deliverables for testing activities include:

- Test specifications and procedures, providing the corresponding review evidence.
- Test logs and file problem reports, in the agreed tool and/or format.
